Madagascar Solar Power Project

Since 2010, we have been installing solar-powered lighting systems for schools in several villages of Kianjavato, Madagascar to improve classroom conditions where power is expensive and not easily accessible.

We are designing a pedestrian bridge to connect the Simulunda community to markets, schools, and medical care across the fast-moving Kalomo River.
